Managing Students Who Self-Injure

Non-suicidal self-injury is an increasingly common behavior among school-aged youth and occurs with regularity. This training will help schools to have well-articulated protocols for detecting, intervening in, and preventing self-injury. Although specific protocols and practices are likely to vary considerably from school to school, this training provides an overview of best practices for detecting and responding to self-injury in school settings.
